

TRI revalidation / refresher training according to EASA part FCL.940(a)(1)(ii)

Objective

Every 3 year a TRI has to complete 1 of the 3 following requirements within the last 12 month:

- > 3 hours of instructing in a TR course (initial / SIM or Aircraft) or a flight of at least 1 hour on Air exercise, with min. 2 take/off and landings, or
- Refresher training at an approved ATO, as per their approved TM / training syllabus, or
- Pass an Assessment of Competence with a TRE on type (TRE must have at least 3 years experience as TRE on type) (UK Doc 43 Appendix C (min. of 3 hours of flight instruction in a applicable FSTD)

Content

The following subjects will be introduced during the course:

- ➤ Health & Safety briefing
- > CRM-TEM refresher Elements of Learning
- Fundamental Principles of the Learning Process
- Facilitation
- > Examiner versus Instructor
- > Flight Examiner Handbook
- **EASA** basic rule structure / homepage
- Basic regulation 216 / 2008
- Part FCL regulation 1178 / 2001
- ➤ ICAO doc. 9841 / ATO rules
- ➤ AMC / GM to part FCL
- EASA explanatory notes for TR & CR endorsement list (monthly new)
- > EASA / TCDS / OEB / OSD / MDR / etc.

The training will be determined by the ATO (Head of Training) on a individual base. Process will be fully up to the ATO, their process, procedures within their applicable manual (TM for TRI). TRI for this part "Refresher" (940 (a)(1)(ii) has regular less instructing experience, therefore this kind of refresher training will aim and focus mainly on the before mentioned items, plus briefing elements, de-briefing elements, practical training issue & it's respective completion, NOTECs / "soft skills" and all associated paperwork / documentation for N.A.A.; company; Pilot; etc.
